For preschool ages, parents and caregivers can pick up a **Takeout Storytime Kit** designed especially for toddlers and preschoolers, containing everything needed to replicate an ImagineIF Early Literacy Class at home. Kits will include songs, science and art exploration, sensory activities and child development tips for caregivers. Kits are available while supplies last.

Students in grades K-5 are invited to explore science, culture, and art through ImagineIF's **Mini Take-home Kit**. Whether exploring chocolate chemistry, recreating ancient sundial technologies, or dissecting owl pellets, kids will relish hands-on learning. Kits are available while supplies last.

The **Teen Take & Make Kit** challenges teens to explore STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) activities through entertaining and fun projects they can do at home. These kits are especially for youth in 6th - 12th grade and can be picked up at any ImagineIF location. While supplies last.
