- The city has indicated that city offices could occupy Depot Park property.
- The facilities committee would like to collaborate with the City regarding any potential future library location in the core area.

## 2. Meetings with County Commissioners

- The committee is keeping the Commissioners informed by meeting with them individually.
- All groups agree that the library needs a new facility.
- The committee would like more feedback from the community regarding potential library sites.

#### 3. Patron/Citizen/Staff Comments?

- Busse requested the committee consider pulling back on the pursuit of a Kalispell location until next Summer to help the momentum of the Bigfork Capital Campaign.
- Wheeler expressed the need to secure the property for Kalispell before the opportunity goes away.
- The committee agrees the Bigfork project is most important at this time, but will continue to look for a suitable property for a future Kalispell library due to the time required to plan and execute a capital campaign.
- The committee is exploring and looking at potential locations only.
