The library continues to offer Early Literacy classes for babies, toddlers, and preschoolers, and STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and math) activities and clubs created for school-aged children and teens at all locations. These programs offer educational activities and inviting spaces for kids and teens after school.

For school-aged children, ImagineIF has created after school activities at all locations, including *LEGO Club*, *Game Day*, and *STEAM Space*. In addition, a new program called *Sensory Play Saturday* will launch this fall at the Kalispell location on one Saturday a month. Kids must be accompanied by an adult.
